Committee reports: Chuck Flynn gave a report from the combined division and association. The VCOS conference is cancelled, the June meeting is on hold probably in October. Tim Wall reported that the Fall Conference was still planned and there will be a reduction in cost (around 40%). The I.A.F.C. election is still coming up the voting will be on line. The I.A.F.C. is still planning the June Hazmat conference.

Ted Schroll on legislation, there is no session planned at this time. There may be a special session in the fall.

Jeff Morrisette gave a report from the commission and the academy. Report on the virus is sent every day on the list serve. Accreditation went out on March 16 and so far at least 50 have passed. Most of the staff is still coming in. The state EOC has been in operation since February. Restart plan is developing though nothing has been announced yet. There will be no June Fire School. Fire Officers weekend is now in August. There is no spring C.P.A.T., it is postponed until further notice. The Commissioners meeting is today (by ZOOM)

3 FEMA grants are open; virus grant for PPE is open until May 15. Safer grant is open until May 15, and the firefighting grant is open until May 22.

The foam program is making progress and will be approved by D.E.E.P.
